Senior Frontend Engineer with 9 years in web development, building production frontends since 2017, with more than 5 years focused on React, TypeScript, and Next.js. Comfortable both starting new applications from scratch and improving older frontend systems without full rewrites. Work covers customer-facing analytics and data-visualization tools, moving codebases from JavaScript to TypeScript, building reusable component libraries, setting up React Query for data fetching, and adding Playwright end-to-end tests. Usually owns frontend delivery from planning to release, and works well across the stack with Node.js, PostgreSQL, and Prisma in remote, cross-functional teams.

- Modernized a live production audit platform without a rewrite, leading the migration from JavaScript to strict TypeScript, helping upgrade React 17 to 18, and continuously delivering new features throughout the transition.
- Introduced React Query as the standard server-state solution, replacing manual Axios data fetching with reusable query hooks that centralized caching, loading/error handling, and retry logic across the application.
- Unified three legacy UI stacks into a single MUI v7 design system, consolidating shared components, design tokens, and styling while completely removing Ant Design from the codebase.
- Migrated drag-and-drop from react-beautiful-dnd to @dnd-kit, restoring compatibility with React 18 while improving accessibility and reducing bundle size.
- Built the frontend testing foundation from the ground up, introducing Playwright, Storybook, and unit testing to protect critical user flows and reduce regressions through CI.
- Architected and implemented a flagship data-analysis workspace, delivering advanced tables, saved views, working-paper annotations, account mapping, and other core workflows using a feature-sliced architecture.
- Replaced Redux with a lean combination of Zustand + React Query + URL state model, simplifying the state layer and improving maintainability.

- Built the frontend for a customer-facing analytics platform using Metabase data, including multi-step onboarding, third-party account integrations, dynamic dashboards, configurable tables, and reusable chart components.
